Romans 2:1-16

Sermon thought: When it comes to being judgmental, human judgment should always take a backseat to divine judgment.

1. Why is it a good idea for someone being judgmental to look into a mirror?
2. Tim mentioned three characteristics of judgmentalism: 1. Self-righteousness; 2. Hypocritical or lack of self-awareness; 3. Presumptuous. Why do you think any of those would cause someone to miss grace?
3. Tim mentioned five characteristics of divine judgment (verses 2-11): 1. Right, just or infallible; 2. Inescapable; 3. Patient; 4. Indisputable; 5. Impartial. Discuss the contrast between divine judgment and human judgment.
4. Read Romans 2:12 and Romans 3:20-28. In what way do the verses in chapter 3 provide hope for the judgementalist?
