Whose Slave Are You?
Romans 6:15-23

Sermon thought: Autonomy is a myth. We will all serve someone or something. When we serve God we will be lead to eternal life; all other masters will lead us to death.

1. Tim talked about the different masters that we can be enslaved to. What are the ways we can discern who and what we serve?
2. The point was made that the issue is not that we need to love the people in our lives less or enjoy the gifts of God less, but the love and joy in our lives needs to be rightly ordered. How does Christ accomplish this in our lives?
