**What Are You Waiting For?
Romans 8:18-25
Marcus Busenitz**

1 - Read Romans 8:1. Compare how the world views suffering with how Paul tells us to view suffering. Do you (or do you know someone) who suffers well? How does that person live out the truth of Romans 8:1?

2 - Read Romans 8:19, 23 and 25. Paul tells us that we should be waiting on God's glory to be revealed, with eager longing and with patience. What glory is going to be revealed (see Revelation 21:3-4)? And how do we wait "eagerly" and with "patience?"

3 - What can you do to further God's kingdom while you wait on God?

4 - Compare Romans 8:24-25 with 2 Corinthians 4:18. God wants us to focus on what we cannot see and to have "hope for what we do not see." Describe this kind of hope. Are you focusing on what you cannot see? What prevents you from focusing on God's future glory?
